



Evolve connects the three pillars to electrification by activating three impactful programs: Commercialization & Infrastructure, Transportation Equity, and Consumer Awareness. ACHIEVEMENTS

The C&I Program assisted public and private fleets, totaling 15,000 fleet vehicles, to determine their electrification strategy. As a result, Evolve identified \$28MM in lifetime savings and an annual reduction of over 17,000 metric tons of CO2. The C&I program plans to continue working with stakeholders such as the Port of Houston to unlock their electrification potential and TxDOT to ensure the reliable, affordable, and equitable distribution of EV charging throughout Houston.

COMMERCIALIZATION & INFRASTRUCTURE

C&I focuses on preparing the Houston region for mass EV adoption by supporting fleet electrification and collaborating with key stakeholders to implement the Regional Infrastructure Strategy for Electrification (RISE Houston) to increase charging accessibility. Evolve works with its members to identify infrastructure expansion projects and funding opportunities, while prioritizing grid resilience.

By connecting the City, utilities and energy providers, and EVSE brokers to property owners and major fleet operators, Evolve is successfully mapping the charging demand, leading discussions to influence EVSE deployment, and supporting transportation electrification across the region.

TRANSPORTATION EQUITY

Evolve believes that electric mobility offers a novel opportunity to disrupt patterns of climate injustices. In Houston, transportation accounts for 67% of ozonecausing NOx emissions, 23% of VOC emissions in the region, and 48% of total GHG emissions. Neighborhoods most impacted are disproportionately lowincome and under-resourced with predominantly BIPOC residents. The U.S. Department of Transportation reports that 38% of Harris County is recognized as both Transportation Disadvantaged Communities and Areas of Persistent Poverty. Electric mobility has the power to catalyze a new era of clean transportation, which prioritizes historically undeserved communities and drives investments to materially resolve critical mobility needs. To increase mobility and access to eMobility within underserved Houston regions, Evolve is connecting communities to major organizations to drive meaningful investments through the eMobility Microgrant Initiative. Houston EV demand is continuously increasing; between 2020 to 2021, total EV sales increased by 138%, while overall new vehicles sales increased by 2.6%. Automotive brands are responding with over 30 new EV models entering the US market in the next 2 years. With change coming quickly, Evolve is ready to equip local automotive dealerships with the resources and channels to successfully connect with aspiring EV owners.

Thus far in 2022, Evolve unveiled their new logo, introduced an Electric Ride & Drive Playbook, designed an eDealer training program, and led multiple digital awareness campaigns. Evolve continues to broaden its reach and amplify its members' and own message on transportation electrification.
