

EQUITY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Evolve Houston's Equity Program addresses systemic transportation disparities in Houston's underserved communities by deploying EV solutions to meet critical local needs. These communities have face limited mobility and higher exposure to pollution due to unreliable and unsustainable transportation options. The Equity Program seeks to reverse these trends through eMobility Innovations that ensure clean air for all.

This program connects Sponsors to grassroots initiatives with unparalleled success rates and interconnected through a governance system that is designed to recognize that those who are closest to the challenge are closest to the solution. Leveraging Evolve Houston's inimitable level of community engagement; Sponsors can benefit by delivering high impact across maximum diversity with minimal risk by partnering with Evolve's eMobility Microgrant Initiative.

At the core of this effort is the eMobility Microgrant Initiative, a dynamic funding platform that empowers local organizations and leaders to develop community-driven EV projects. Since its launch in 2023, the initiative has funded over 50 impactful efforts, including a no-cost electric microtransit service.



Evolve Houston has awarded over 50 grants and many excellent projects remain unfunded, highlighting the need for additional investment.

MICROTRANSIT SERVICE OVERVIEW

Evolve Houston's microtransit service began in June 2023 as a grassroots pilot under the eMobility Microgrant Initiative, launching with just two electric vehicles. It has since grown into a key part of the METRONow strategy, now operating over 15 vehicles across five zones and serving thousands monthly.

Designed to close transit gaps in underserved areas, this service offers free, on-demand electric rides that connect residents to critical destinations and METRO transit stops; 46% of trips begin or end at a METRO station. It's a vital link for seniors, families, and low-income residents.

Backed by a \$1.05M expansion grant in 2024, the program is scaling further. Strong public support and a positive EY assessment highlights its cost-effectiveness, community impact, and case for continued growth.

Evolve is pioneering a regional Center of Excellence for all-electric microtransit to support Houston METRO through community engagement, research, thought leadership, and advisory services. Its mission includes:

- > Accelerating advancement in microtransit and electrification.
- > Leading research, data analytics, and community engagement.
- > Guiding Houston METRO toward optimized, equitable, and sustainable microtransit solutions.

By aligning community needs, clean vehicles, and public partnerships, the Community Connector bridges transit gaps and redefines mobility. Evolve's pilot-to-partnership model shows how local innovation can spark systemwide change.
