

GRANTS PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Grants Program, formally known as the eMobility Microgrant Initiative, addresses transportation gaps in Houston's under-served communities by deploying clean mobility solutions that meet critical local needs. Residents in these neighborhoods often face limited access to reliable transportation and greater exposure to air pollution. The program removes barriers through initiatives that expand access to electrification, including microtransit pilots, community-led charging projects, and other locally driven solutions.

Members have the opportunity to sponsor and support projects that generate tangible benefits for communities while connecting with local organizations and leaders. By funding and scaling impactful projects, members help drive measurable improvements in mobility, environmental quality, and community well-being. Participation also allows members to showcase their commitment to sustainable innovation, strengthen local partnerships, and gain visibility for authentic community impact.

MICROTRANSIT SERVICE OVERVIEW

The Community Connector is an all-electric microtransit service that closes transit gaps in Houston's under-served neighborhoods. It began in June 2023 as a grassroots pilot under the Grants Program, launching with just two electric vehicles. The program has since grown into a key part of the METRONow strategy, now operating over 15 vehicles across five zones and serving thousands of riders monthly. Nearly half of trips, 46%, begin or end at a METRO transit station, providing essential connections for seniors, families, and low-income residents.

Backed by a \$1.05M expansion grant in 2024, the program continues to scale. Members can sponsor or collaborate to support mobility solutions, reduce emissions, and expand accessible transportation. Participation allows members to demonstrate leadership in inclusive innovation, strengthen partnerships with civic and community organizations, and contribute to scalable, measurable solutions that improve transit access and operational efficiency in Houston.

The Community Connector offers members the opportunity to drive measurable community impact while supporting Houston's clean transportation future.
