

Evolve Houston eMobility Grants: Round 3 Awardees

In 2024, Evolve Houston awarded funding to 22 community-led projects through Round 3 of Evolve's Grants Program (formerly the eMobility Microgrant Initiative). This program provides one-time grants of up to \$15,000 to support innovative clean transportation solutions in historically underserved communities across Greater Houston.

These projects are being implemented throughout 2025, driving meaningful progress on EV infrastructure, clean energy workforce training, community EV education, and sustainable mobility solutions that are shaping a cleaner, healthier, and more connected Houston.

Round 3 eMobility Grant Winners:

- **Bullard Center for Environmental Justice – Trail Show on Tap: Electrifying the Path**

Deploying an electric utility vehicle to support eMobility education, service projects, and sustainability outreach at Texas Southern University and along the Columbia Tap Trail.

- **Bullard Center for Environmental Justice – Texas Southern University HBCU Environmental and Climate Justice**

Educating TSU students about e-bikes and e-scooters to promote sustainable commuting and air quality research.

- **Mina II Society Consulting – The Power in Sunnyside**

Hosting clean transportation workshops and outreach in Sunnyside, including EV education and e-bike giveaways to drive community engagement.

- **HYPE Freedom School – EV Literacy on the Lawn**

Youth-led EV education and service-learning project in Sunnyside culminating in a public community awareness event.

- **Black Girls Do Engineer Corporation – EVolve Together: Empowering Communities**

Hosting community EV education workshops and STEM programs for youth to build interest in clean transportation careers.

Conducting EV transportation surveys, outreach, and education to raise community EV awareness and participation in the Third Ward.

Expanding a zero-carbon food delivery program in Third Ward using e-bikes to reduce food insecurity and promote green transportation careers.

Installing EV chargers to reduce emissions, expand charging access, and support community EV adoption.
